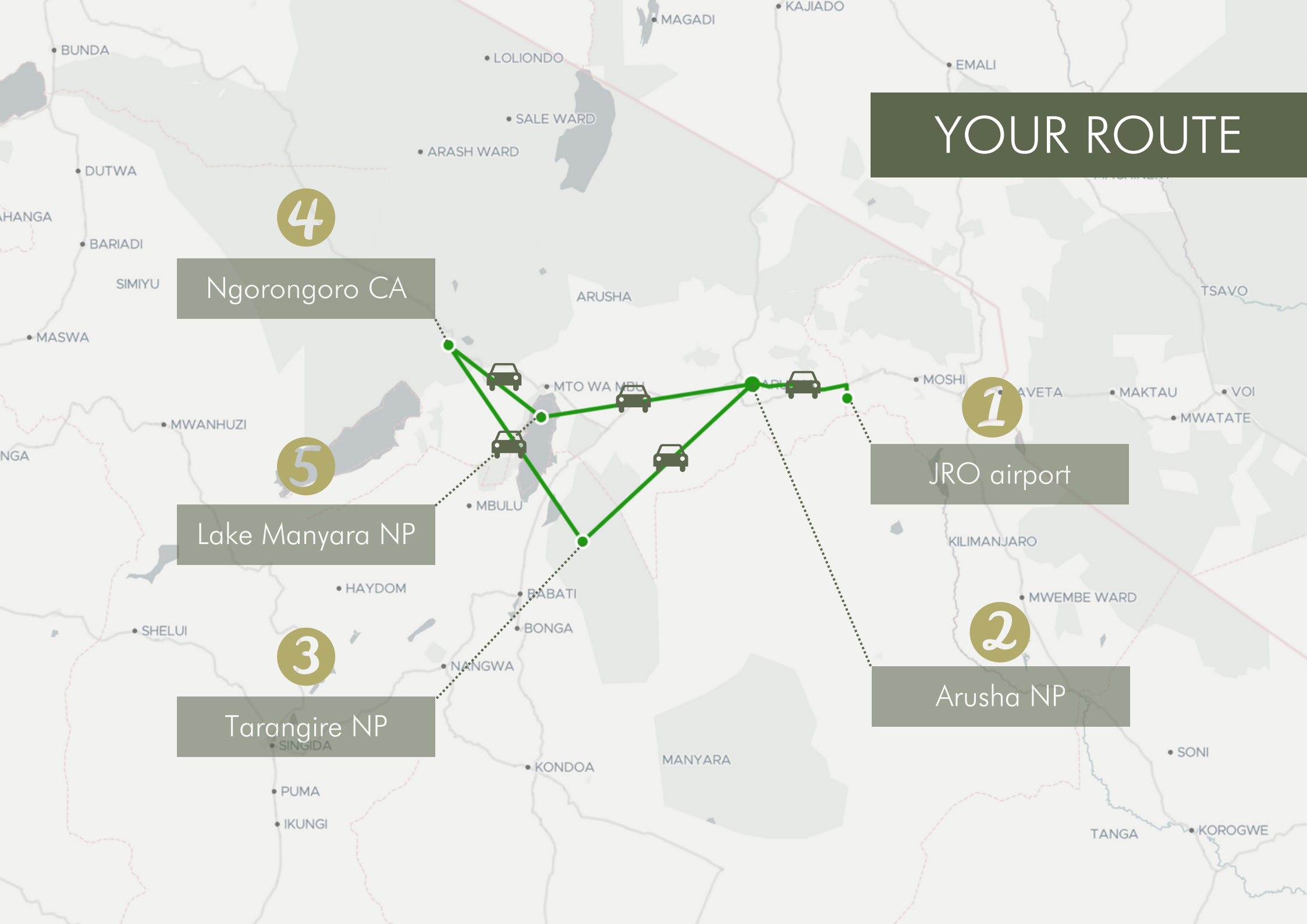

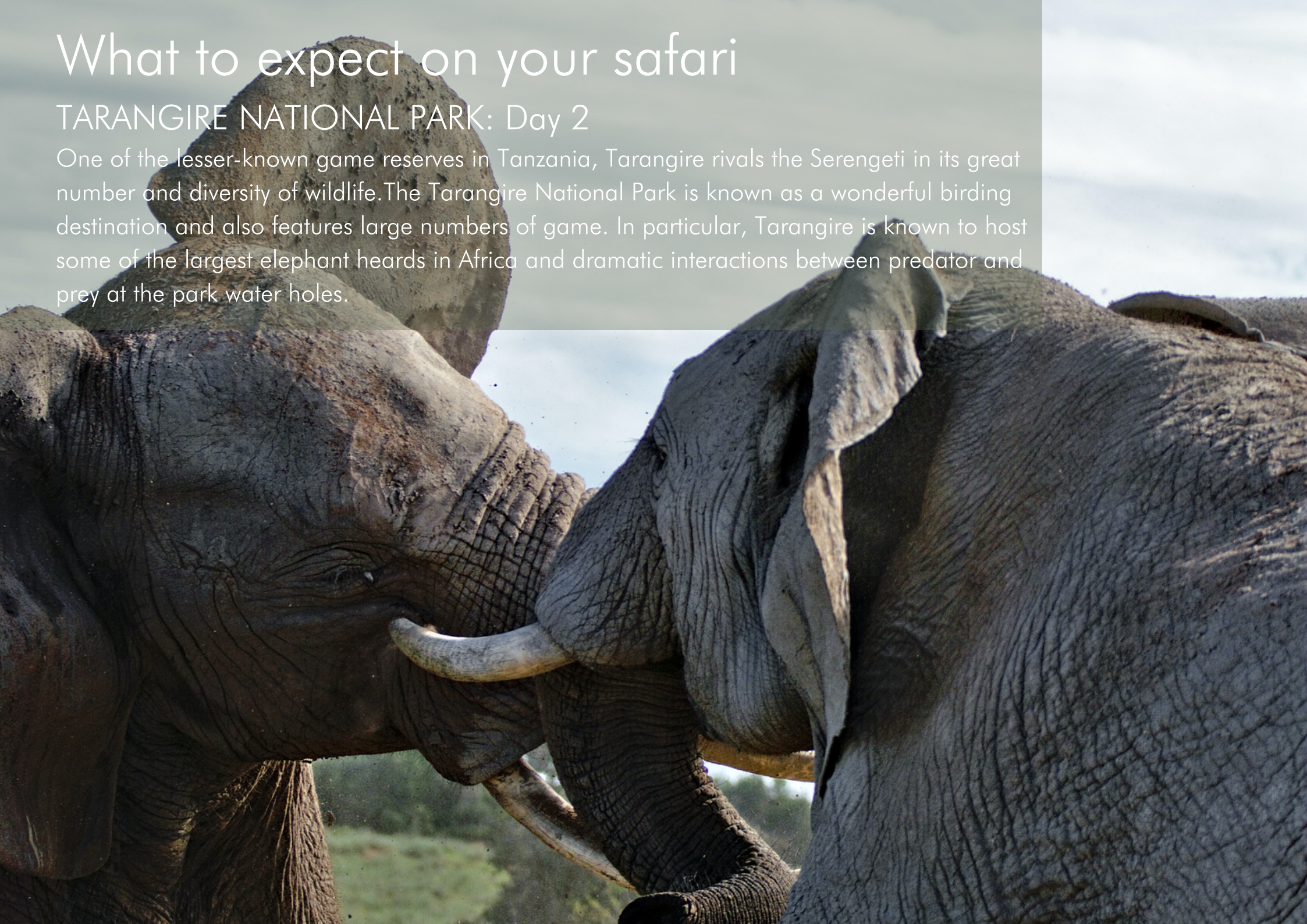

What to expect on your safari

TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK: Day 2

One of the lesser-known game reserves in Tanzania, Tarangire rivals the Serengeti in its great number and diversity of wildlife. The Tarangire National Park is known as a wonderful birding destination and also features large numbers of game. In particular, Tarangire is known to host some of the largest elephant herds in Africa and dramatic interactions between predator and prey at the park water holes.



What to expect on your safari

NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA: Day 3

Ngorogoro crater, the largest inactive, intact and unflooded caldera in the world, was formed when a volcano exploded and collapsed in on itself 2 to 3 million years ago. It is now one of the best places in Africa for wildlife viewing, with the Big 5 and an extraordinary concentration of predators in the area.

What to expect on your safari

LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK: Day 4

Lake Manyara National Park centres around its eponymous alkaline lake, a key habitat for hundreds of bird species. It is home to a famous tree-climbing lion population and a large variety of eco-systems ranging from steep mountainside and dense woodlands to Rift Valley soda lake. There is always something interesting to see and experience in the Lake Manyara region.

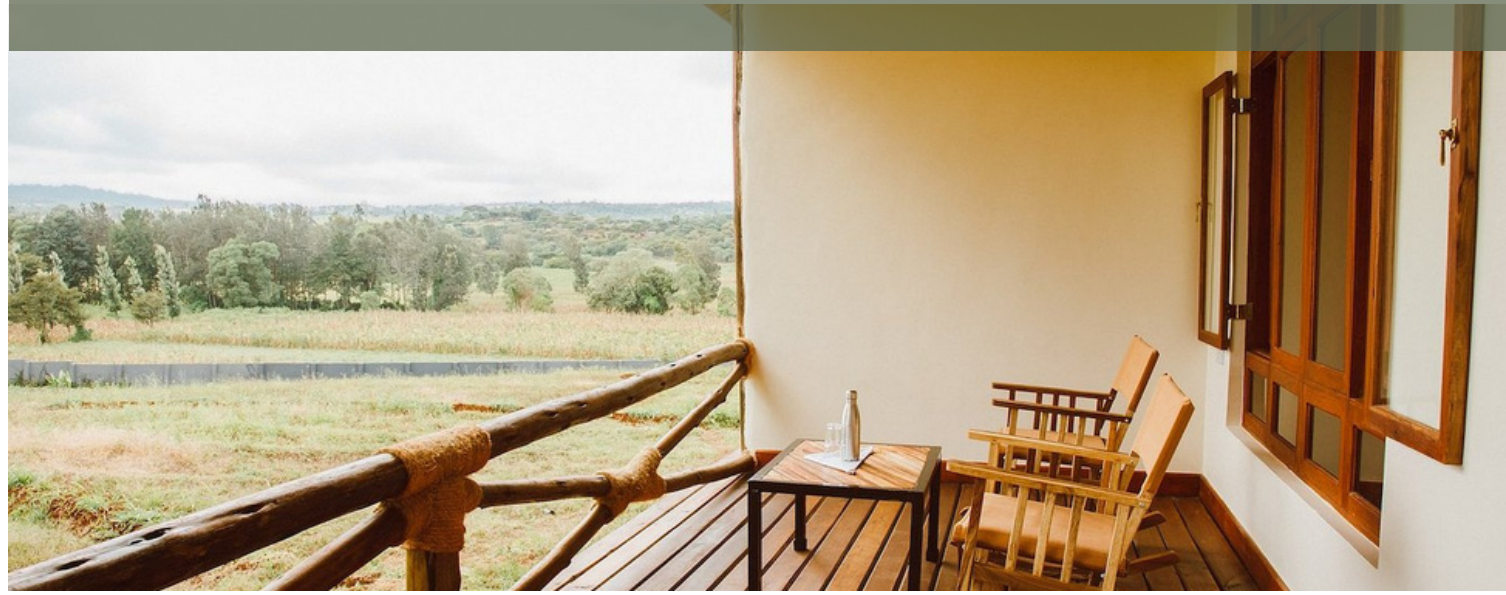

DAY 1

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) or Arusha, you will meet your guide. Our Safari expert will give you a detailed safari briefing after which you will be transferred to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Main Destination: Arusha

Meals: Bed and breakfast (Drinks not included)

DAY 2

After the breakfast, you will be heading to Tarangire National Park, where ancient baobab trees tower over some of the largest herds of elephants in all of Africa keep a lookout for the hundreds of bird's species. Tarangire is known for dramatic interactions between predator and prey at the park water holes. In the evening, after game drive, you will go to your lodge for dinner and overnight stay.

Main Destination: Tarangire National Park

Meals: All meals included

Drinking water 1.5 liter per day per person (Other Drinks not included)

DAY 3

In the morning today after early breakfast at the lodge you will be heading to Ngorongoro crater. The Ngorongoro Crater is a 250 sq km collapsed volcano which is now a self-sustained ecosystem with a population of 20,000 large animals. Crater floor is the home of the endangered rhinos, with the highest population of hyenas. Later in the evening, drive to Karatu for your overnight.

Main Destination: Ngorongoro Crater

Meals: All meals included

Drinking water 1.5 liter per day per person (other drinks not included)

DAY 4

Today after breakfast drive to Lake Manyara National Park. Explore the deep forest where the big tuskers are roaming, the blue monkeys jump from the top branches of the ancient tamarind, mahogany and giant's baobab, using their tail as an extra limb. Visit the lake shore where you can spot pink and lesser flamingo's hippos and storks. In the late afternoon drive to Arusha to end your trip or extend your holiday on the beach (see our beach extension package).

Main Destination: Lake Manyara National Park

Meals: Breakfast & lunch
