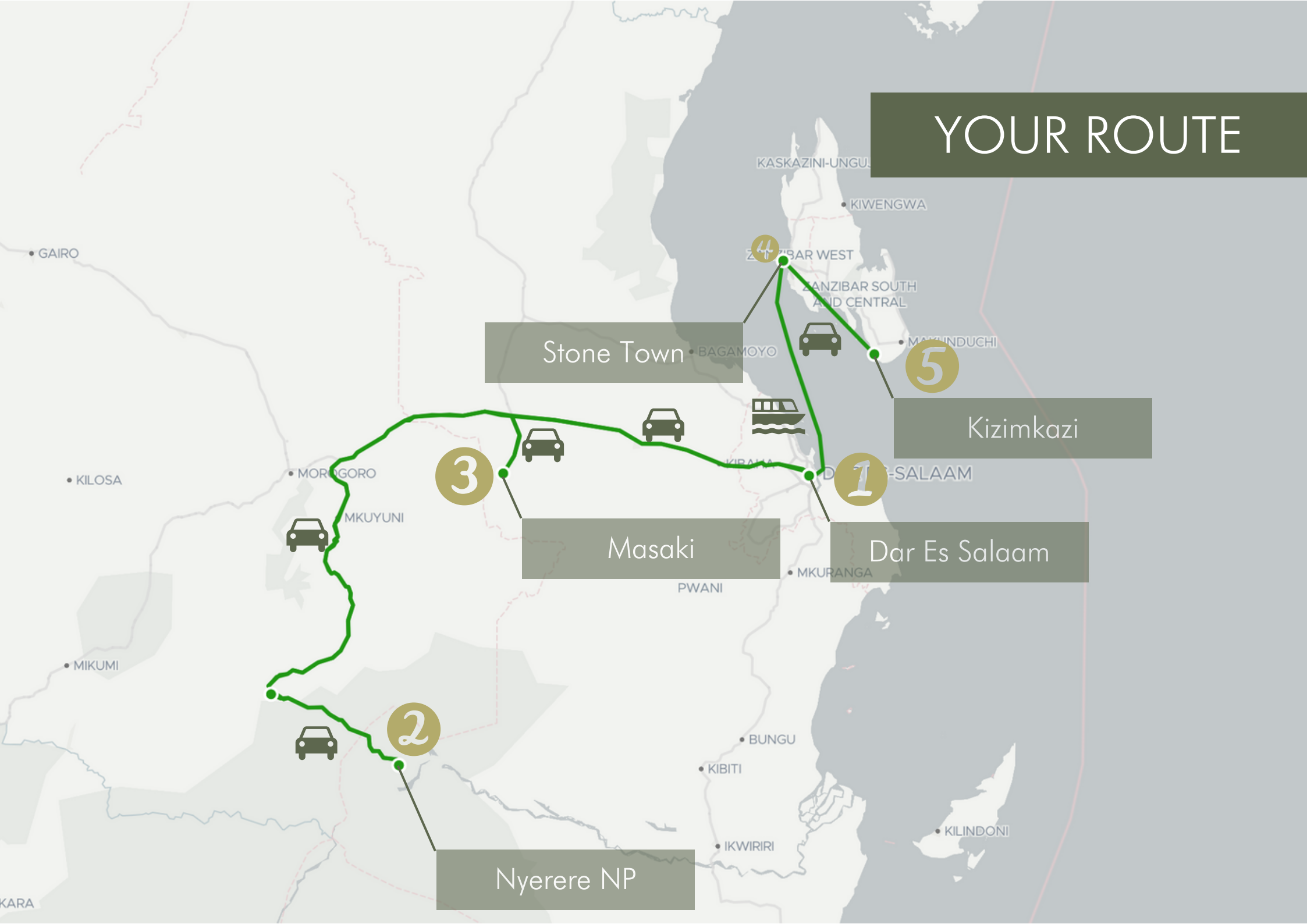

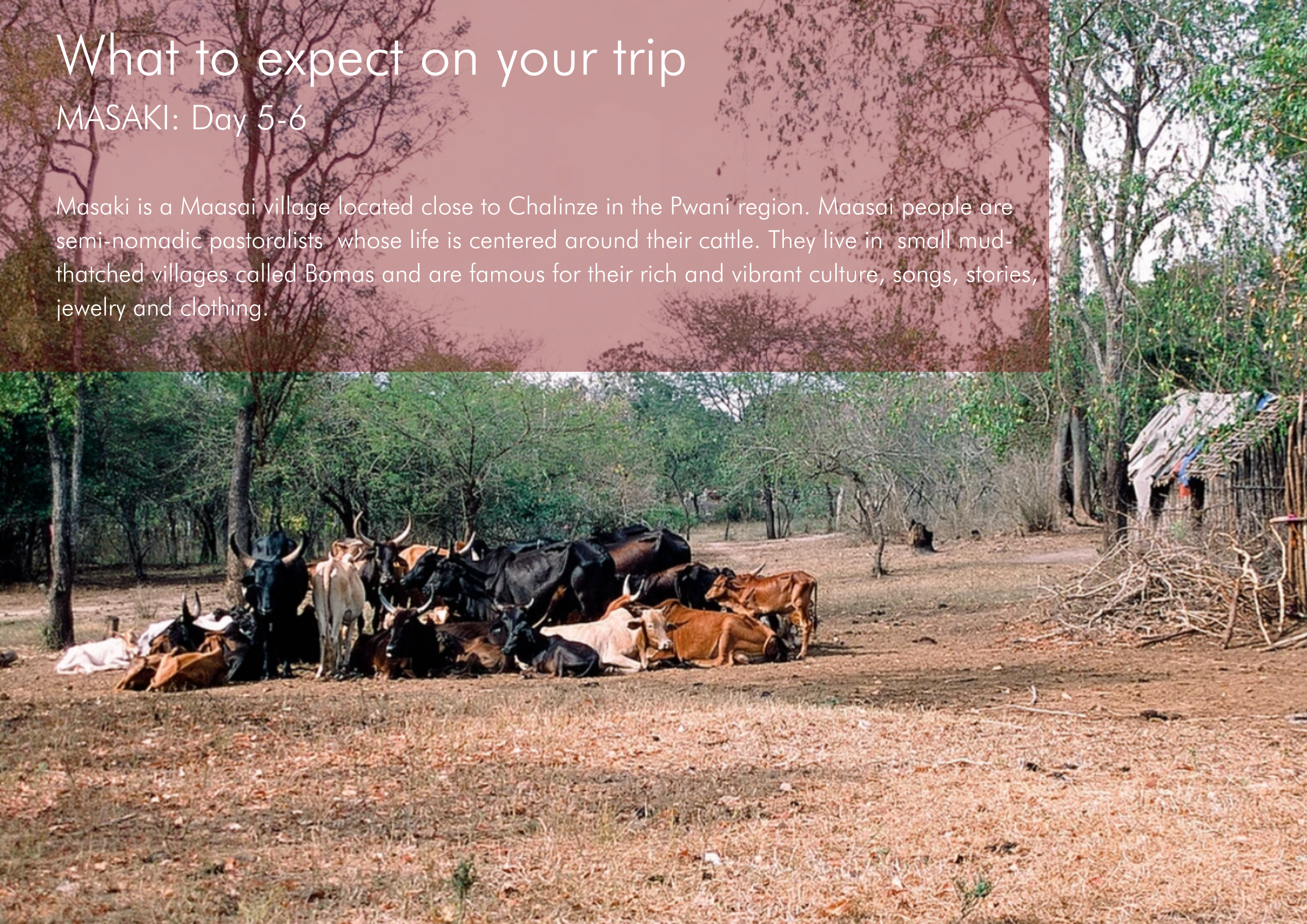

They live in small mud-thatched villages called Bomas and are famous for their rich and vibrant culture, songs, stories, jewelry and clothing.

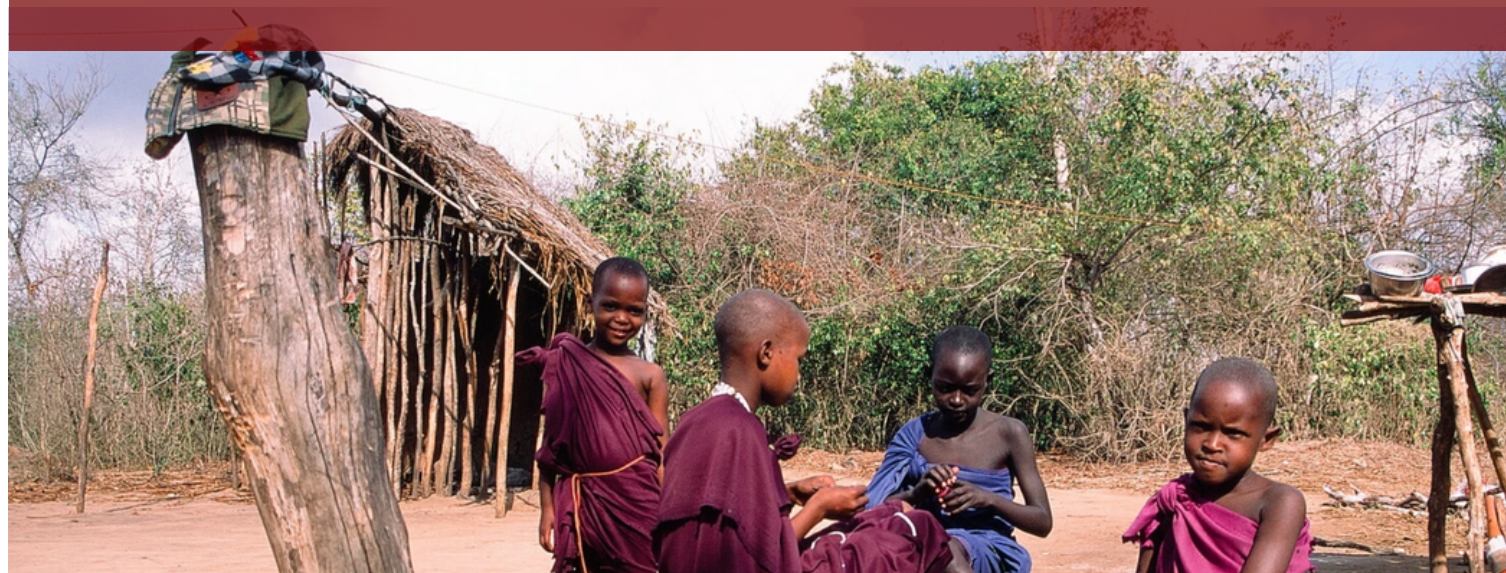

DAY 1

Welcome to Tanzania! Upon arrival in Tanzania, you will meet your guide at the Julius Nyerere International Airport who will escort you to the shores of the Indian Ocean for a relaxing evening before the beginning of your adventure.

Main destination: Dar Es Salaam

Accommodation : Mediterraneo Boutique Hotel

Meal plan: Dinner

DAY 2

After breakfast, you will start your journey to the village of Kisaki. The village of Kisaki is the last village before the immensity of the Nyerere National Park. In the evening, you will go for a walk in the forest, learn about Maasai traditional medicine, and enjoy your first sounds of the bush.

Main destination: Kisaki, Morogoro Region

Transfer time : Approx. 4h30

Accommodation : Lemara Eco Camp

Meal plan: Full-board

DAY 3

After an early wake-up call, you will jump in 4x4 open-roof vehicle for your first day of safari. The open-roof will enable you to have a 360° view while on a safari. Accompanied by your guide, you will spend the day exploring different regions of the Nyerere National Park, in seek for beautiful animal sightings. The Nyerere National Park is home to several vast ecosystem and is thriving with life. You might spot all the animals that you want to see already in your first day of safari ! Breakfast and lunch will be taken inside the park.

Main destination: Nyerere National Park

Accommodation : Lemara Eco Camp

Meal plan: Full-board

DAY 4

After an early wake-up call, you will head to the Nyerere National Park to resume your safari. In the morning, you will meet a ranger from the park and experience the savannah by foot. During 1h30 – 2h, you will walk inside the park and open your eyes to the small wildlife, invisible from the car and get a new point of view. After lunch, you will resume your safari day.

Main destination: Nyerere National Park

DAY 5

After breakfast, you will start your journey to the Maasai village of Masaki. You will be welcomed by your host Asenwa who will get you familiar with local customs and lifestyle. You will go around the Maasai boma and visit the school of Masaki. In the evening, watch the ceremonial of the cattle returning home.

Main destination: Masaki village

Transfer time : approx 5h

Accommodation : Homestay

Meal plan: Full-board

DAY 6

At dawn, your day as a Maasai will start. You will assist the family in the morning activities such as Milking the cows, sharing morning news around breakfast. During the day, Asenwa and the other women will teach you the art of beaded Maasai jewelery and you will learn how to cook Ugali, a Tanzanian national dish.

Main destination: Masaki village

Accommodation : Homestay

Meal plan: Full-board

DAY BY DAY

DAY 7

After breakfast, you will head to the Dar Es Salaam Ferry port, onboard for a 2 hours trip on the indian ocean to reach Stone Town, Zanzibar. After enjoying some time off in the old city of Stone town, you will meet your Zanzibari guide Aicha to taste the richness of the Zanzibari food at the night market.

Main destination: Stone town

Accommodation : Zanzibar Coffee House

Meal plan: Full-board

DAY 8

Today, you will learn about the history of the Zanzibar island. In the morning, you will head to the slave museum and memorial to learn about slave trade in east africa. In the afternoon, you will head to the spice farm and discover the large variety of spices grown in Zanzibar. After the tour at the spice farm, you will head to Kizimkazi, a beautiful village by the indian ocean and you will meet your new host Mama Farida.

Main destination: Kizimkazi

Accommodation : Homestay

Meal plan: Full-board

DAY BY DAY

DAY 9

Live at the peaceful pace of the Kizimkazi inhabitants. Today, you will learn how to cook freshly-fished fish and participate in the daily activities of the family of Mama Farida. In the afternoon, you will enjoy some time at the beach and in the evening, discover the fish market on the beach of Kizimkazi.

Main destination: Kizimkazi
Accommodation : Homestay
Meal plan: Full-board

DAY 10

Early in the morning, Farida's brother will take you on a boat trip to the reef for a morning of snorkeling. In the afternoon, go on a bike ride around the village and up to the twin Kizimkazi village. Go out for a drink and enjoy an evening walk.

Main destination: Kizimkazi
Accommodation : Homestay
Meal plan: Full-board

DAY 10

Today is your last day. Your driver will come to pick you in Kizimkazi and escort you to the airport. Karibu tena Tanzania (Welcome again to Tanzania) !
