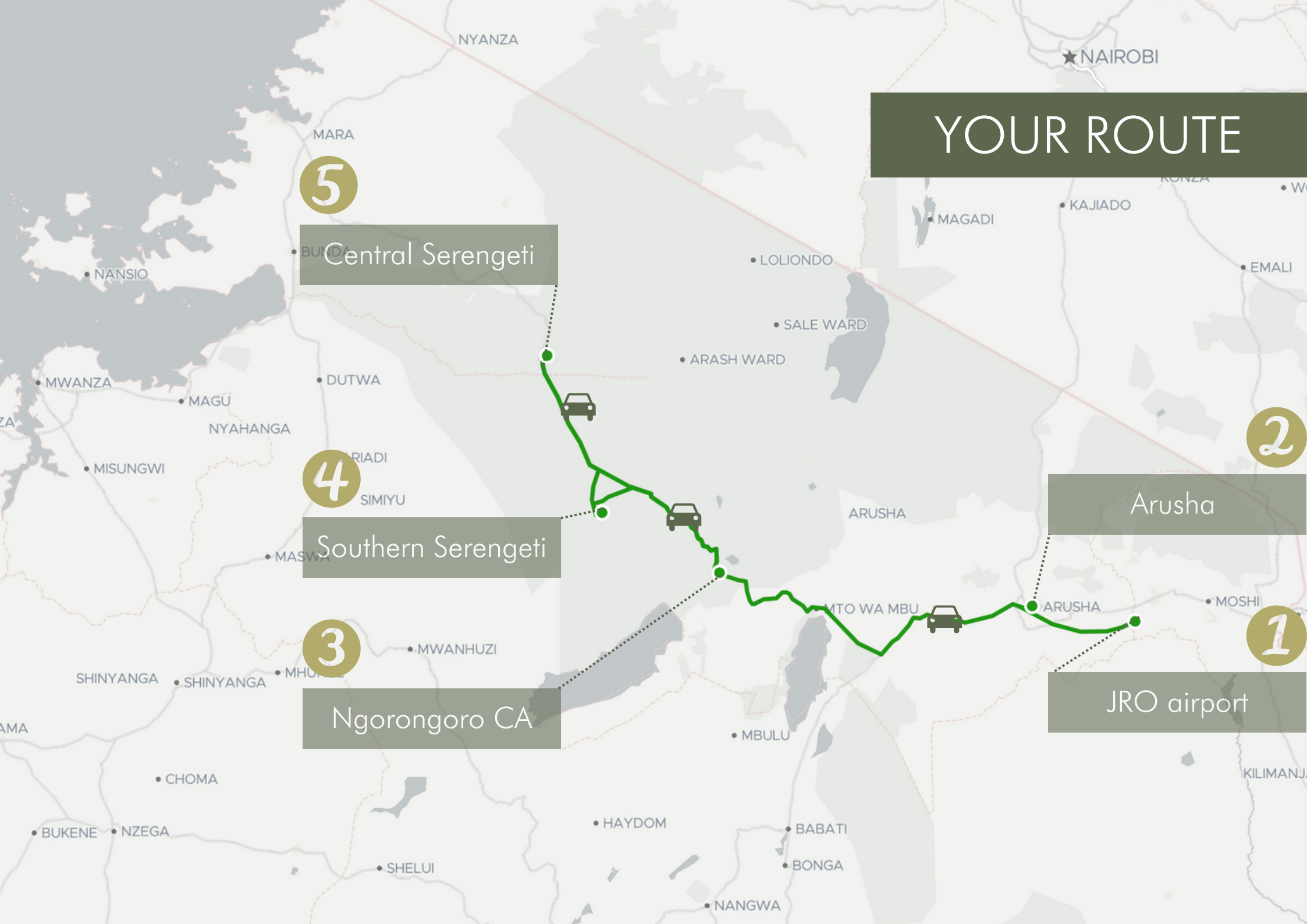

What to expect on your safari

SOUTHERN SERENGETI: Day 2-3

Every year, one of the most extraordinary wildlife events is taking place. Over a million wildebeest and several hundred thousand zebra undertake a year-long migration through the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem in search of nutritious grass and water. In January, February and March, the plains of the south, rich in nutritious grass provide the best conditions for raising new-born calves. The plethora of wildebeests and calves attracts predators by numbers and give birth to dramatic hunting scenes.





What to expect on your safari

HOT AIR BALLOON: Day 3

Some things are worth waking up early for. Each flight is a different journey dictated by the direction of the wind, where the sights and sounds rise from the ground to meet you. This is part of the adventure. During your flight, you will get a unique view point on the endless plains of the Serengeti, alternating between close-up sightings and high altitudes panoramic views.



What to expect on your safari

CENTRAL SERENGETI: Day 4

Central Serengeti is studded with many rocky granite outcrops, known as kopjes, where you will be looking out for lions, and cheetahs. Thick woodland is home to several varieties of primates from vervet monkeys, olive baboons to bushbabies and on the plains, elephants are seen in numbers.



What to expect on your safari

NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA: Day 5

Ngorogoro crater, the largest inactive, intact and unflooded caldera in the world, was formed when a volcano exploded and collapsed in on itself 2 to 3 million years ago. It is now one of the best places in Africa for wildlife viewing, with the Big 5 and an extraordinary concentration of predators in the area.



DAY BY DAY

DAY 1

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by your guide. After greetings, you'll will be transferred to Arusha for a safari briefing, and overnight stay. Breakfast will be provided at the hotel.

Main Destination: Arusha

DAY 2

After breakfast drive to Ndutu in Ngorongoro conservation area. During the rain time the migration of wildebeests and Zebras are congregate in this area for calving, predators follow the migration and make this area full of action.

DAY 3

In the early morning, you will be picked up for your hot air balloon flight. After a 1 hour flight, you will have a breakfast in the bush and resume your safari day in the southern Serengeti.

DAY 4

Today, enjoy the beautiful Serengeti sunrise in the morning, and witness the sea of waving grass and the rocky hills. The central Serengeti is know for its large number of cats and big birds.

DAY 5

Today after breakfast, drive to the crater floor.

Ngorongoro Crater was formed from a collapsed volcano. It's now a self-sustaining ecosystem with the densest predator population in all of Africa – you may be able to spot the Big 5 in a single afternoon.

Main Destination: Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Today, you will be transferred to the Kilimanjaro airport.
